Green: Happy with topics and I believe falls within Health & Safety education.

Purple: The subject of the topic is vague and can fall into both acceptable and unacceptable topics. It may also be politicised and institutionalised.

Grey: Could be useful but may have a negative impact on the child causing distress, depression or even provide ideas for evil.

Red: I feel are negative, questionable and controversial and not suitable for under-aged children.
